

Associate - ANPAS

- The submissions shall consist of twelve monochrome, colour, colour slides or digital images. The set of work to be submitted must be of high technical standard.
- A sound knowledge of the principles of photographic technique and artistic photography must also be evident. Good pictorial arrangement, proper treatment of subject matter and if prints; superior print quality are essential. Simplicity and effectiveness of subject arrangement and a variety of subject matter in the submission is recommended.
- The submissions shall be considered by a panel appointed by the Board of Directors in July and December of each year. They will report to the Board of Directors upon scrutiny of the applications received. The Board of Directors then considers each application with the report therein.
- No candidate is elected unless four-fifth of the panel of selectors votes in favour of his selection.

RULES

1. All prints must be properly mounted and no smaller than 30cm x 40cm nor larger than 40cm x 50cm. Digital images must be 2000 pixels x 3000 pixels.
2. Closing date shall be on 30 June and 31 November of each year.
3. Associates shall have the right to place the letters **ANPAS** after their names as long as they are members of the Society.
4. Members who are selected shall receive a Certificate. Such a certificate is the sole property of the Society. Any Associate who ceases to be a member of the Society shall be required to return the Certificate to the Society.
5. Successful applicants are required to submit a set of digital images (minimum 2000 pixels x 3000 pixels) to be used by the Society's archive, website, exhibition and publication. A photograph of the photographer must also be submitted. The Society reserves the rights to publish these images as deemed fit for matters related to the NPAS without the payment of any fees to the authors, but due credit would be given where appropriate.
6. The decision of the Board of Directors shall be final and no further correspondence shall be entertained.

Fellow - FNPAS

- Only ASSOCIATES of The National Photographic Art Society of Sri Lanka may apply for this Honour.

- The **submissions** shall be considered by a panel appointed by the Board of Directors. They will report to the Board of Directors upon scrutiny of the applications received. The Board of Directors then considers each application with the report therein, and if deemed suitable, selections are approved for the award of the fellowship.
- No candidate is elected unless four-fifth of the panel of selectors votes in favour of his election.

RULES

1.0 Photographic Exhibition

Organised and conducted an exhibition at a suitable and public venue and

- a) Has exhibited a number of photographs of size 25 cm X 20 cm or above
- b) Where the number of images exceeds forty (40)
- c) The images exhibited are presented in a methodical and appealing manner
- d) The images are of Monochrome, colour or of a combination

That the images confirm and conform to the photographic and artistic ability of the applicant and so decided by a panel of selectors with four-fifths in favour of this election

OR

2.0 World Wide Web application

A candidate who is maintaining a collection of images in electronic format, and maintaining this in an established form can be considered provided that,

- a. The Website / blog site has a collection of a minimum of 50 or more images
- b. That the website / blog site has been maintained for a period of one calendar year or more
- c. That the site has attracted a cross section of visitors from local and foreign and that this can be established with net statistics
- d. That the images confirm and conform to the photographic and artistic ability of the applicant and so decided by a panel of selectors with four-fifths in favour of this election

1. All candidates must apply for the title.
2. Closing date shall be on 30th June and 31st November of each year. A panel of five examiners shall meet in July and December.
3. Fellow shall have the right to place the letters **FNPAS** after their names as long as they are members of the Society.
4. Members who are elected shall receive a Certificate. Such a certificate is the sole property of the Society. Any Fellow who ceases to be a member of the Society shall be required to return the Certificate to the Society.
5. A least four-fifth of votes are required to be recommended for selection.
6. Successful applicants are required to submit a set of digital images (minimum 2000 pixels x 3000 pixels) to be used by the Society's archive, website, exhibition and publication. A photograph of the photographer must also be submitted. The Society reserves the rights to publish the pictures without the payment of any fees to the authors.
7. The decision of the Board of Directors shall be final and no further correspondence shall be entertained.
